

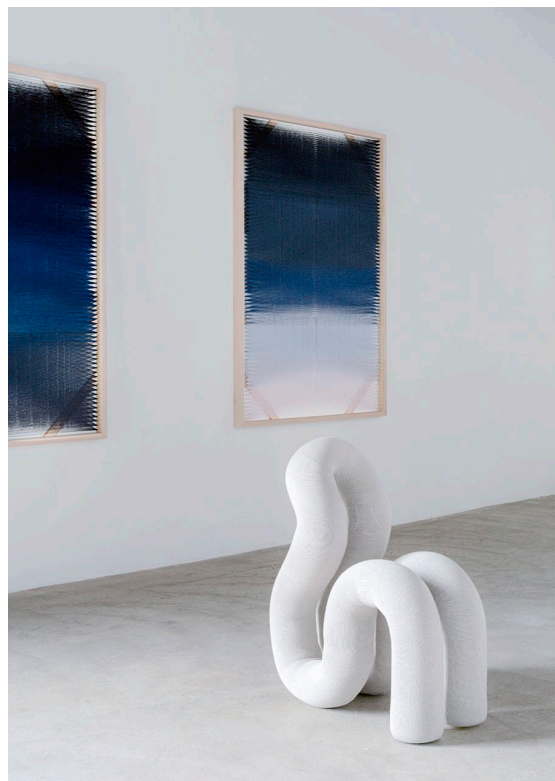


SATURDAY SELECTS
